Your application at SRH

Simply apply online via our application portal for your application to study with us.

The portal is called [Dream Apply](#) (click it or scan the QR-Code below). There you create an applicant account and apply for the study program you want. You provide all the necessary information about yourself and upload the required documents.

After we receive your application, you will receive a confirmation by email.

We will check your application individually and let you know if we still need documents or if you are sure of a place.

Next, you sign the study contract and send it back to us, preferably by mail. Everything else will be handled by our Student Service department. They will inform you about the next steps and you will be enrolled. How does that sound? And once you have taken part in our introductory week, you can start studying!



1st You create an user account: DreamApply

2nd You fill in information and upload all necessary documents

3rd You submit your application (you can submit several applications for several study programmes/ study locations)

4th Whenever you contact us: name us your application number

5th We check your application

6th We let you know if you're eligible. If you are, we may ask for pending documents and send you a study contract

Your admission at SRH

1st You tick boxes, sign the contract and supplements

2nd You send the documents to: study-inNRW@srh.de

3rd The person in charge at SRH signs the contract

4th We send you the signed documents

5th If asked: You take part in an eligibility exam/interview

6th You tick boxes, sign the contract and supplements

7th If asked: You send missing documents to: study-inNRW@srh.de

8th We send you the final admission letter

Euro) are always payable. A „wai-
ver“ of individual components is not
possible.**

In the monthly service charges (100 Euro) the usual operating costs consist of electricity, water, drainage, garbage disposal, heating, warm water, house insurances, property tax, property drainage, street cleaning, elevator costs as well as cleaning costs (the rooms are cleaned twice a week). The costs are fixed and not negotiable. Also included are the following leisure time opportunities near the apartment: Sports hall, fitness room, and swimming pool (a utilization plan is to be determined). Table tennis tables and billiard tables (These facilities can also be used (unless other-

wise occupied). Table tennis bats and balls, billiard cues and balls can be rented from the information desk. The outdoor sports facilities (tennis courts and multipurpose court) can also be used, but you must bring your own tennis rackets and balls. Also included are the costs for the internet (Wi-Fi). The beds are equipped with mattresses, comforters, and pillows. You only need your own sheets and linen. Laundry can be washed and dried for a small fee in the laundry cellar; however, you must bring your own washing powder. In the underground garage, there are plenty of possibilities to park bicycles, mopeds, or motorcycles; no extra fee is charged for this. The communal kitchen is equipped with sufficient dishes, cutlery, pots/pans, cupboards, sink, hot-plates, refrigerators, chairs, and tables. The bus stop is in front of the apartments. In the morning, the buses run every 10 minutes, later every half hour or late in the evening about every hour.
